

## **INVITATION TO BID**

### **CHERRY VALLEY FIRE STATION 167 CHERRY VALLEY ROAD WATER MAIN EXTENSION**

#### **DUVALL-KING COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT 45 DUVALL, WASHINGTON**

Sealed proposals will be received for the work described below by Duvall-King County Fire District 45 at their office located at 15600 1st Avenue NE, Duvall, Washington 98019. Proposals will be received until 3:00 pm local time, Wednesday, June 5, 2019. All bids received will be opened publicly and read aloud no sooner than 3:05 pm.

The work consists of extending the water main of King County Water District No. 119 to serve a proposed fire station to be constructed at the intersection of Cherry Valley Road and 318<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE. The work includes the installation of approximately 1,235 linear feet of 10 inch diameter water main, 62 linear feet of 8 inch diameter water main, 3 fire hydrants, along with miscellaneous appurtenances. Also included is pavement repair and county road shoulder restoration as required by the King County right-of-way permit. Water main material shall be Class 52 ductile iron. Duvall-King County Fire District 45 will award the work on the basis of the lowest qualified bid. The Engineer's estimate for the work is \$230,000. The earliest expected start date is July 1, 2019, subject to permit issuance and selected bidder successfully providing the required bonds and insurance. The work shall be completed within 60 calendar days of the Contract date.

Bidders are notified to examine thoroughly the Contract Documents and the site of the work. If there are questions as to the intent or meaning of the Contract Documents, the bidder should ask the Engineer of King County Water District No. 119 for an answer to their questions (Contact: Joe Dominczyk, District Engineer, (253) 952-7797).

Each bid shall be accompanied by a Bid Bond, Cashier's Check or Certified Check amounting to five percent (5%) of the bid, and made payable to Duvall-King County Fire District 45.

Duvall-King County Fire District 45 reserves the right to reject any and all bids, or to waive any irregularities or informalities in any bid or in the bidding. No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of thirty (30) days after the date set for the opening thereof.

Free-of-charge access to project bid documents (plans, specifications, addenda, and Bidders List) is provided to Prime Bidders, Subcontractors, and Vendors by going to [www.bxwa.com](http://www.bxwa.com) <<http://www.bxwa.com>> and clicking on "Posted Projects", "Public Works", and "Duvall-King County Fire District 45". This online plan room provides Bidders with fully usable online documents with the ability to: download, view, print, order full/partial plan sets from numerous reprographic sources, and a free online digitizer/take-off tool. It is recommended that Bidders "Register" in order to receive automatic e-mail notification of future addenda and to place themselves on the "Self-Registered Bidders List". Bidders that do not register will not be automatically notified of addenda and will need to periodically check the on-line plan room for addenda issued on this project.
